



PRIVACY POLICY

Thank you for visiting Eaagle. Your privacy is very important to us.

To better protect your privacy, we provide this statement explaining our online information practices and the choices you can make about the way your information is collected and used at this site. This statement covers only data collected through the site and service. This statement does not cover any other data collection or processing, including, without limitation, data collection practices of other web pages to which we link or data processing practices of users of our service (e.g., users of our Eaagle Service).

We comply with the EU Safe Harbor Certification framework as set forth by the US Department of Commerce that covers personal data collected from or about persons in the European Economic Area.

INFORMATION COLLECTED BY EAAGLE

Within Eaagle site or service, you can maintain a profile of actively submitted data. When you request information, subscribe to a mailing list or for a service, register as a user, post to one of our forums or communities, send or respond to an online survey or otherwise actively send us data, we usually collect data such as your name, email address(es), telephone number(s), country of residency, and certain information related to the business you represent (if any). In connection with chargeable services, we will also collect payment information (e.g., credit card number and related verification information).

Only persons who provide us with the requested personally identifiable information will be able to participate in the site's activities, services and offerings.

When you visit the site, we also passively track information on your computer and Internet connection. We use technology that many other web sites employ, including, without limitation, "cookies" or small data files stored on your computer's hard drive, to collect information. In some instances, we also use cookies to collect information in connection with future visits from that web site, to recognize you as a previous visitor and to track your activity at our site. You can refuse cookies by turning them off on your browser, but please note that this may adversely affect user experience and convenience.

USE OF INFORMATION

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, note that **WE WILL NOT SHARE YOUR IDENTITY OR YOUR DATA.**

We **DO NOT** share, sell, rent or trade personal information with third parties for their promotional purposes.

We sometimes use this information to communicate with you, such as to fulfill a request by you for an online newsletter, or to contact you about your account with us.

We use the information you provide about yourself to fulfill your requests or to respond to your inquiries about our offerings, and to offer you other information, products, programs or services that we believe may be of interest to you.

If you use any of our services with a corporate email account (i.e., an account for employees, contractors, etc., as opposed to a personal email account with a general email service provider such as AOL, Hotmail, Yahoo, Gmail, etc.), and such corporation signs up for an enterprise account with us, we may inform such corporation of your use of our service, so that you can benefit from enterprise pricing and any other benefits negotiated by the corporation for its registered users or otherwise arising from such coordination.

We may share your information:

- As required by law or in the interest of protecting or exercising our or others' legal rights, e.g., without limitation, in connection with requests from law enforcement officials and in connection with court proceedings.
- In connection with a prospective or actual sale, merger, transfer or other reorganization of all or parts of our business.

We reserve the right to use and disclose any information collected via the site that is not in personally identifiable form.

We sometimes use the non-personally identifiable information that we collect to improve the design and content of our site and to enable us to personalize your Internet experience. We also may use this information in the aggregate to analyze site usage, as well as to offer you products, programs, or services. We collect passively tracked data primarily for purposes of administering, protecting and improving our site and our systems, to better understand the preferences of our site visitors, to compile aggregated statistics about site usage, and to help personalize your experience on our site. We also use may cookies and passively tracked data to protect the integrity of surveys, e.g., to prevent survey respondents from responding to the same survey twice.

We may on occasion combine information we receive online with outside records to enhance our ability to market to you those products or services that may be of interest to you. If you have signed up to receive our e-mails and prefer not to receive marketing information from this site, follow the "unsubscribe" instructions provided on any marketing e-mail you receive from this site. Finally, we will not use or transfer personally identifiable information provided to us in ways unrelated to the ones described above without also providing you with an opportunity to opt out of these unrelated uses.

Although we take appropriate measures to safeguard against unauthorized disclosures of information, we cannot assure you that personally identifiable information that we collect will never be disclosed in a manner that is inconsistent with this Privacy Statement.



COOKIES & WEB BEACONS

To enhance your experience with our site, many of our web pages use "cookies." Cookies are text files we place in your computer's browser to store your preferences. Cookies, by themselves, do not tell us your e-mail address or other personally identifiable information unless you choose to provide this information to us by, for example, registering at one of our sites. However, once you choose to furnish the site with personally identifiable information, this information may be linked to the data stored in the cookie.

We use cookies to understand site usage and to improve the content and offerings on our sites. For example, we may use cookies to personalize your experience at our web pages, save your password in password-protected areas, and enable you to use other areas of our site. "Web beacons" are small pieces of code placed on a web page to monitor the behavior and collect data about the visitors viewing a web page. Our site sometimes may offer content that is sponsored by or cobranded with identified third parties. By virtue of these relationships, the third parties may obtain personally identifiable information that visitors voluntarily submit to participate in the site activity. We have no control over these third parties' use of this information. The site will notify you at the time of requesting personally identifiable information if these third parties will obtain such information.

From time to time we may use a reputable third party to present or serve the advertisements that you may see on our Web pages. These third party ad servers may use cookies, web beacons, clear .gifs or similar technologies to help present such advertisements, and to help measure and research the advertisements' effectiveness. The use of these technologies by these third party ad servers is subject to their own privacy policies and is not covered by our privacy statement.

SECURITY

We have put in place appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and help prevent unauthorized access, maintain data security, and correctly use the information we collect online. However, transmissions over the Internet are never 100% secure or error-free. We do reasonable steps to protect your personal information from loss, misuse, and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction. It is your responsibility to safeguard any password and User ID you use to access the site and to notify us at support-us@eaagle.com if you ever suspect that your password or User ID has been compromised. You are solely responsible for any unauthorized use of the site conducted via your password and User ID.
